## Pastor's Corner

When Dawson Trotman passed away he probably left a legacy of discipleship on this earth that will never be matched. Trotman was the founder and President of Navigators International and published, in his time, many of the best books and curriculum on effective discipleship. His organization went on to become one of the largest publishers of Christian discipleship materials in the world.

Trotman loved the water and was an expert swimmer. But he died by drowning in Schroon Lake, New York on June 18, 1956 after a freak boating accident. The speeding motor boat he was riding in bounced on a wave and threw Dawson Trotman and two little girls into the water. In his last moments, as they all struggled in the water, he lifted one girl out and then went down and got the other girl and lifted her out of the water as well. He then slipped under the waves himself and was not found again until the dragnet found him a few hours later. A man named Larsen was on that boat, when Trotman died, and he said "The entire United States Navy couldn't have saved Daws that day -- it was God's time." Time magazine ran an article on Trotman's life the next week and they put a caption beneath his name, and it read "Always Holding Somebody Up." In one sentence, that was Trotman's life -- investment in people, in honesty and humility, holding them up.



How about you? The Bible tells us to "encourage one another daily, while it is still called today" (Hebrews 3:13). What are you doing to lift up the people who are around you?
