The letter came from a visitor out of Tuscola, Illinois. She and her two sisters dropped by the church one afternoon during Vacation Bible School week, and asked if they could go into the sanctuary and pray. I think you will enjoy the explanation and the story.

Dear Pastor Danhof,

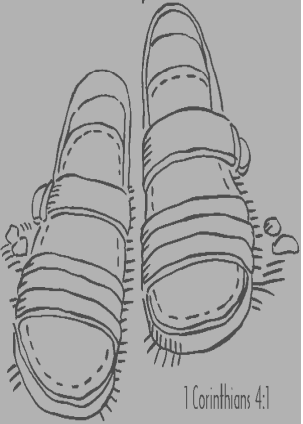
Enclosed please find a check, and please use it for your ministry to your sister church in Ukraine. My two sisters & I were

vacationing in Door County last week. I hadn't seen my younger sister Kyle from Spokane, WA in three years. We adopted her when she was 5 (now 53) – originally she was my first cousin. Her brother passed away in Dayton, OH while we were together [there in Door County]. We had bought 3 roses to symbolize our love for him – we wouldn't be able to go to Ohio for the actual funeral.

Kyle wanted to find a church open where she could leave the 3 roses on the altar last Thursday. Several were locked until we came by your church & saw the cars & Kyle talked to a kind woman in your office. We were able to have a prayer in your sanctuary & left the roses. The Vacation Bible School children's tee-shirts were spread out but children were elsewhere.

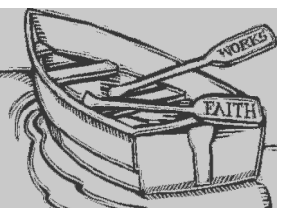

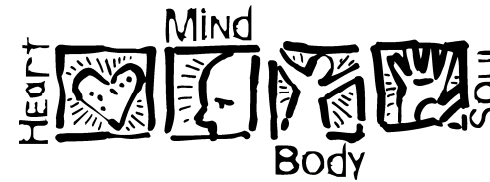
